Dear Parents/Caregivers,

As part of our Science Unit 'Living Things' we are going on an excursion to Mogo Zoo!

Outcome: STe-8NE Identifies the basic needs of living things.

Date: Monday, 23rd October 2017

Time: We will be leaving at approximately 9:30am and returning to school by 2:00pm.

Cost: \$20 This includes entry to the zoo and bus travel. If your child has an annual pass, the cost is just \$5 for the bus travel.

Please send your child to school in their school uniform and comfortable shoes. (Not Sports uniform)

What to bring:

- School hat.
- Lunch, recess and fruit (no lunch orders for Kindergarten on this day)
- Refillable drink bottle
- Zoo pass (if your child has one)

* Please do not send children with any money on the day, as they will not be able to spend it at the canteen or zoo shop.
